Re: **Liability and Indemnity Insurance**

Scouts Canada's insurers have agreed to incorporate The Canadian Fellowship of B-P Guilds as named insured's under the Comprehensive General Liability, Umbrella Liability, and Directors' & Officers' Liability insurance policies effective, March 26, 2007. The Indemnity (Accident) insurance has also been modified to include The Canadian Fellowship of B-P Guilds.

A summary of coverages is outlined briefly below. Please note that full policy descriptions will be provided to The Canadian Fellowship of B-P Guilds on a "confidential" basis.

General Liability insurance: This policy covers the legal liability for accidental Bodily Injury and/or Property Damage to third parties, with a \$2,000,000 limit per occurrence.

Umbrella Liability: This policy affords an excess coverage above and beyond the primary General Liability policy mentioned above.

Directors' & Officers Liability: This contract affords protection against actual or frivolous claims alleging a Wrongful Act committed by an individual in the exercise of their duties. Coverage is provided to both individuals and the organization.

Indemnity Insurance: This policy provides indemnity in the event of injury while engaged in Guild activities. Please note that this coverage is very basic and is supplemental to any other Accident insurance held by the individual.

These protections apply to all registered Canadian-domiciled members of B-P Guilds.

It is important to remember that any Guild member involved in activities with youth members must meet the same screening criteria as Scouts Canada members. (PRC's)

FAQs:

Who is insured? All B-P Guild members who are duly registered and have paid their annual fee.

U.S. Citizens: Unfortunately these coverages do not apply to members who are not Canadian citizens.

Does this mean that Guild members can attend local/National Scouts Canada events? As outlined above, yes, however this only applies if you have met the Scouts Canada Screening criteria (PRC's, interviews and reference checks) when working with youth members.

Coverage duration: These Liability coverages end March 1, 2008 while the Indemnity policy expires December 1, 2007, for registered members who have paid in full.
